

Our Practice Is Participating in the MDPCP-AHEAD (Maryland Primary Care Program – Achieving Healthcare Efficiency through Accountable Design)

Your health care providers' office at Johns Hopkins is partnering with the program, Medicare, and the Care Transformation Organization (CTO) - Johns Hopkins Alliance for Patients (JMAP), to work together with you to coordinate your health care, and create a health care plan that is best for you.

Under the program, your primary care practice will receive additional resources to improve the care we offer to you and other patients. These resources will help to better coordinate your health care. There will be no additional cost to you, and you will benefit from more coordinated health care.

Your Medicare benefits ARE NOT changing.

You still have the right to use or visit any provider or hospital that accepts Medicare.

We may recommend that you see particular health care providers for your specific health needs, but it is always your choice which provider you use or hospital you visit.

MDPCP-AHEAD is something we participate in with Medicare. There is nothing you need to do to continue getting care from us.

Your health information from Medicare helps us give you better care.

Our goal is to give you the best care.

Medicare will share some of your personal health information with us and CRISP (Chesapeake Regional Information System for our Patients). CRISP is Maryland's designated health information exchange and supports healthcare by securely sharing health information to improve your health care.

Your shared information gives us a more complete picture of your health.

Your privacy is very important to us. We put safeguards in place to make sure all your personal health information is protected.

You can choose not to share personal health information about care you received.
